God is a forgiving God. God's love for us is unconditional and the very foundation upon which we are forgiven. No matter what we have done or how long we have been away, God is going to welcome us back with loving, open arms. As we feel sorry for our sins and acknowledge our sinfulness, we return to God time and time again.

Forgiveness is a virtue that should be widely accepted because after all, no person is above making mistakes, and coexistence itself depends on it. To not acknowledge that we are imperfect is to take away our humanity and prevent actual peace from ever having a chance. "Real peace is not just a matter of structures and mechanisms," wrote Pope John Paul II. "It rests above all on the adoption of a style of human coexistence marked by mutual acceptance and a capacity to forgive from the heart. We all need to be forgiven by others, so we must all be ready to forgive. Asking and granting forgiveness is something profoundly worthy of every one of us."

When we forgive others, it can internally bring us more peace, hope, gratitude and joy as we let go of resentment. Pope John Paul II wrote, "Thanks to the healing power of love, even the most wounded heart can experience the liberating encounter with forgiveness." Forgiveness allows us to create the potential to become people who are based in love instead of fear, which contributes to a better world overall. It can be done silently in the heart at any time as well as outwardly when we express feelings of compassion towards others who may have hurt us.

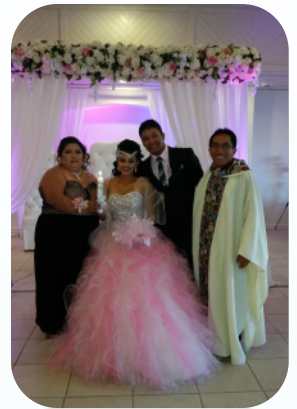

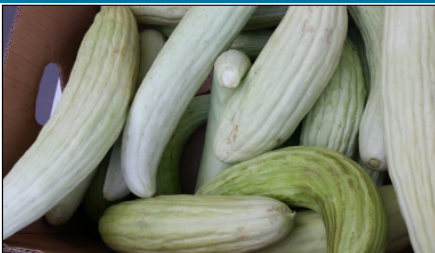

UNA REFLEXIÓN PARA NUESTRO TIEMPO

La conciencia y el reconocimiento de la propia responsabilidad en relación con el mal parecen estar desapareciendo. Las personas alegamos ser víctimas de las circunstancias, de las maquinaciones de poderes impersonales que dominan el mundo (globalización, mercadotecnia, redes sociales, etc.); sin embargo, está disminuyendo la honestidad para reconocer la responsabilidad en relación con los delitos y pecados que cometemos. Demasiado rápido compramos la seductora propuesta de que no debíamos culpabilizarnos ni traumatizarnos por complejos de culpa. Sin autocrítica y sin honestidad no es posible destrabar los mecanismos que nos convierten en personas agresivas y egoístas. El llamado "efecto lucifer" que transforma a personas ordinarias en agentes de violencia y de crueldad, está visible en nuestra sociedad violenta: existen responsables y hay que reconocerlo. Desde la óptica cristiana contamos con el camino de la conversión y la reconciliación para lograrlo. hacia nosotros.
